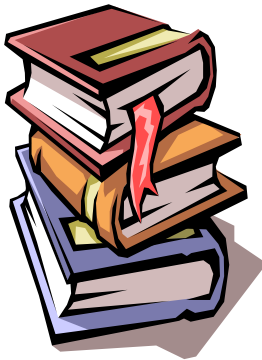

2011 Scholarship Application

General information and instructions for applying for NBCFAE Annual Scholarship:

Before the application can be processed, the applicant must provide to the Education,

Recruitment, and Training Chairperson a complete application packet, which includes:

1. The completed application form. *(Please type or print legibly using blue or black ballpoint pen.)* The applicant must **sign** the Declaration (Part VI); otherwise it will **not** be processed.
2. **Official** transcripts from each school attended or last semester attended.
3. Letter(s) of recommendation (minimum requirement: one).
4. A letter of acceptance from prospective college, university, vocational or technical school unless already enrolled at one of the aforementioned (submit the college of your choice).
5. All applicants must be a high school student expecting to graduate this spring, high school graduate, hold a GED certificate or be a returning college student.
6. All applicants **must** have a **2.5 grade point average or higher**. (**Official** transcripts must be included [sealed envelope] for verification.) Transcripts may be sent separately. Transcript arriving unsealed will not be accepted. Grade reports will not be accepted.
7. Completed application packets must be **postmarked** no later than **April 30, 2011. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
8. **Official** Transcripts of all post-secondary schools must accompany this application, as well as letter(s) of recommendation.
9. Please indicating your major course of study (college level):

10. **If you are awarded a scholarship, an 8x 10 photographs (professional attire) must be submitted to this office no later than June 12, 2011 or you will not receive your scholarship.**
11. Applicants who are NBCFAE members or their dependents must indicate the Chapter and Region affiliation plus the name and the relationship of the NBCFAE member.

DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS FOR NBCFAE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Part I – Personal Data

Checking the applicable items. If you are currently in High School, anticipating graduation, select “High School Graduate.” If you have attended college for at least one semester, then select “College Undergraduate.” If you have graduated from High School, but have not attended any postsecondary educational institution (College/Technical School), select “High School Graduate.” “Degree currently seeking. Current High School Students should select “High School Diploma.” High School Graduates, GED, Technical School, or College Undergraduate should select the appropriate degree category. Date expected to graduate or degree conferred. High School Students should put the date they expect to graduate from High School. GED and High School Graduates enter the date they received their diploma. College Undergraduates enter the date you expect to receive your college degree.
